

ATTENTION **ALZHEIMER'S** PATIENTS AND CAREGIVERS



The Virginia Commonwealth University School of Pharmacy is conducting a **study** of patients with Alzheimer's disease who are being treated with one of the following medications:

Aricept[®], Exelon[®], or Razadyne[®]

and

**are also taking
at least one other medication
for conditions such as:**

depression

sleep

allergies

dizziness

Parkinson's disease

**overactive bladder, or
behavioral disturbances.**

The VCU IRB **approved** study will be conducted at your home or the VCU General Clinical Research Center and consists of three visits over six months.

At each study visit, 2-3 hours of **testing** will be conducted.

Participants will receive \$50 per visit to assist with expenses if they are seen at the VCU General Clinical Research Center.
